In the event of bad weather, April 6th conversations will be moved inside to the Learning Center.

As Heritage Park residents, your voices are important to us. These conversations are the foundation of what we hope to be a frequent and continued engagement with Heritage Park residents in the redevelopment process. Conversations will help RHA gather initial information and additional conversations will follow in the future.

Redevelopment planning is in the early stages and is not anticipated to begin yet. Residents are urged to continue complying with all parts of the Lease Agreement as redevelopment plans are not imminent. Do not begin preparing for relocation until you receive written notification from RHA to do so.

We hope that you will join the conversation time(s) that works best for you. We look forward to hearing your thoughts and we are eager to use your feedback as we shape the new Heritage Park together.
