Through a partnership with Legal Aid of North Carolina, the county provides free legal support for tenants who need legal counsel for mediation services or to negotiate filed evictions with landlords. This legal counsel is typically provided at no cost for tenants who cannot reach an agreement with their landlords or need legal counsel for mediation services.

### **Self-Help Clinics on a matters unrelated to eviction:**

**You can attend free Self-Help Clinics to learn how to handle certain basic legal issues without hiring an attorney.** You will receive all the guidance and paperwork necessary to walk out of the clinic and into the courthouse. Clinics are hosted monthly or quarterly at Legal Aid offices, churches, community centers and other locations throughout North Carolina. All clinics are completely free, but advance registration is required due to space limitations at most locations. The clinics will provide you with general legal information and guidance only. The clinics will not provide you with specific, individual legal advice.
