

In Wake County, the Raleigh Housing Authority administers the Emergency Housing Vouchers (EHV) via the prioritization criteria developed by the Wake County CoC. All voucher recipients must come through the Coordinated Access System and be on the community-wide By-Name List (BNL) of people experiencing homelessness. The BNL identifies individuals and households who are currently enrolled in a Street Outreach, Emergency Shelter, or Transitional Housing project in HMIS. Everyone on the BNL is assessed for a housing resource such as an Emergency Housing Voucher.
